HOLOCAUST REMEMBRANCE MEMORIAL SERVICE

On May 1st the annual Holocaust Remembrance Memorial Service took place in our main sanctuary. Hundreds of Congregants from seven Synagogues: Flushing-Fresh Meadows JC, Bellrose JC, Hillcrest JC, Hollis Hills Bayside JC, Israel Center of Conservative Judaism, Temple Gates of Prayer and The Jewish Center of Kew Garden Hills attended the service.

Keynote speaker Cynthia Zalisky, the Executive Director of the Queens Jewish Community Council spoke about the rise of anti-Semitism in Europe. The QJCC is a not-for-profit social service agency. As a child of Holocaust survivors, Cynthia has devoted her adult life to Holocaust Education and combating anti-Semitism. The program included a candle lighting ceremony by survivors and their families, prayers and readings by Ohr Chadash Students. The service concluded with the entire assemblage singing the Hymn of the Partisans and Hatikvah.

SHAVUOT

On June 10th we celebrated our annual Shavuot Luncheon. It was a very enjoyable event. Following Yizkor Services, we had a delicious dairy luncheon of baked salmon, steamed vegetables, fries, blintzes and cheesecake.
